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Dear Families of Year 1

June 2025

Welcome back to the new term here at Manor Park First School. We hope you have all had a lovely break and are ready to get back to school for our last term of Year 1. Here is some information to outline what your child will be learning this term in all the different curriculum areas. Do encourage your child to tell you about what they have been learning at school – it really helps the children to secure their learning when they discuss it with others.

 In Mathematics we are learning: Place Value - to count, read and write numbers 100. To count in multiples of twos, fives and tens Multiplication and division - to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays Fractions -to recognise, find and name a half and a quarter of an object, shape or quantity Measurement (time) - tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times Geometry to recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes 	 In English we will be using two fiction books; 'Commotion in the Ocean' and 'The Snail and the Whale', We will be looking at non-fiction books and reports about snails. Our outcomes will be: to write a diary entry from the perspective of the snail to write detailed descriptions of a chosen sea creature to explore words that rhyme and use these to write their own rhyming couplets to write a non-chronological report about snails
In RE we are learning: Why do Christians pray to God and worship him? We will be learning some of the right words to talk about Christians praying at mealtimes e.g. grace, God, amen. We will understand that Christians pray and worship God in different ways. We will recognise at least some of the words from the Lord's' Prayer.	 In Geography we are learning: to name the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas to name key landmarks in the United Kingdom to recognise the natural environment in the UK and describe it using key vocabulary to use a UK wall map or atlas to locate and identify the four countries
In PSHE we will be exploring the topic of 'Changing Me'. We will be learning how to cope positively with change, in particular the changes we will see in our bodies as we grow.	In Music we are: • recapping all Musical Elements vocabulary: Pitch, Dynamics, Tempo, Timbre, Pulse, Rhythm • understanding how the musical elements can be used to represent a story

In **PE** we are learning about:

Athletics - we are learning about moving at different speeds over different distances, developing balance, changing direction quickly, hopping, jumping and leaping at distance, throwing for distance, and throwing for accuracy.

Striking and Fielding - we are learning about underarm throwing and catching. We will be developing overarm throwing, hitting a ball, collecting a ball, as well as learning how to get a batter out, how to play games and score points.

We will also be preparing for Sports Day - a letter will be sent to families this week with details.

In **Computing** we will be learning about 'programming animations' through Scratch Jr.



Learners will explore the way a project looks by investigating sprites and backgrounds. They will use programming blocks to use, modify, and create programs. Learners will also be introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.

<u>Maths</u>



We look forward to a fantastic Summer 2 term, Year 1 Team. In Science we are learning about Plants


We are going to:
